Subject: Approval of the Beneficial Reuse of Waste Tires as Safety Barriers at Umigo Indoor Kart Racing, Alameda County, TPID No. 1615489-01

Dear Mr. Buck:

On September 19, 2013, the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) received your request for approval of the beneficial reuse of waste tires in the construction of safety barriers at Umigo Indoor Kart Racing, located in the City of Livermore, Alameda County. Your request included information regarding the beneficial use of waste tires in safety barriers to reduce potential harm to race participants and the machinery without causing negative impacts to public health and safety or the environment. Staff have determined that the use of waste tires as safety barriers at the Umigo Indoor Kart Racing qualifies as a beneficial reuse as defined in Title 14, California Code of Regulations (14 CCR), Section 17346(f). As an approved beneficial use, the waste tires will not be determined to be stored or disposed and use does not require the issuance of a waste tire facility permit from CalRecycle.

Please note that if the beneficial use of waste tires is discontinued, Umigo Indoor Kart Racing or the legal operator and/or business owner is fully responsible for the removal and the proper recycling or disposal of the tires in a manner consistent with the waste tire laws and regulations.

CalRecycle staff or their authorized agents are authorized by regulation to inspect and/or carry out investigations at Umigo Indoor Kart Racing to determine continued compliance with requirements of 14 CCR Section 17346(f) for the beneficial use of the waste tires as well as other applicable waste tire laws and regulations.
