Please be advised that the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), acting as the Solid Waste Enforcement Agency (EA) for San Luis Obispo County, has received and approved a RFI Amendment per Title 27, California Code of Regulations (27 CCR), Section 21665(c). This public notice was prepared pursuant to 27 CCR 21660.1

**Project Description**

City of Berkeley Solid Waste Management & Transfer Station is an existing Large Volume Transfer Station operating under a full Solid Waste Facilities Permit issued on August 22, 2011. The application package to amend the RFI requests the following changes: approval of an updated site plan for the unloading and storage of waste, drainage control, maintenance program, equipment, and updated Transfer Processing Report.

The EA finds that the proposed changes are consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documents, is consistent with State Minimum Standards, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current Solid Waste Facilities Permit. The EA approved the RFI Amendment on October 28, 2016.
