**SUBJECT: Approval for a 3<sup>rd</sup> Extension of the Compliance Schedule for the West Central Landfill, Facility No. 45-AA-0043, Shasta County**

Dear Ms. Serio:

On August 1, 2014, I disapproved your request for a third extension request of the compliance deadline pending operator submittal of an application for permit revision. I have since received and considered your agency's October 7, 2014 letter asking me to reconsider the extension request. Your letter includes documentation of completion of additional milestones, including submittal by the operator of a permit revision application, hearing of the EIR addendum with subsequent approval by the Board of Supervisors on October 14, 2014, and receipt by your agency of the "Perimeter Monitoring Boundary Extension Work Plan".

Therefore, I hereby approve your request for the extension of the compliance schedule until March 26, 2015 with the understanding that the operator continues to show significant additional progress toward submittal of a *complete* application package *and* obtaining a SWFP. If the operator fails to meet the March 26, 2015 final compliance deadline, the LEA should take further enforcement in accordance with the issued N&O.
