As mentioned during the Grant Workshop on Thursday March 19, the California Compost Coalition supported the comments of CRRC to allocate \$2 million to rural compost programs.

The rural community has been underserved with composting facilities, and where anaerobic digestion facility development is too expensive on a unit costs.

There are some CEQA ready compost facilities ready to apply. As rural counties entitle more compost facilities, there will be more demand in the future for seed money from grant programs to initiate the develop of compost facilities where \$2 million may not be enough.
