Addendum No. 1

To the Request for Proposal (RFP) Secondary Method DRR11030

1. The following questions were submitted in response to the RFP and answers to each follow the question.
 - Q1. The RFP indicates a current maximum budget of \$1.2 million. Just to clarify, is this the budget for the economic study alone, or is it the budget for the suite of studies and contractors CalRecycle is retaining for the overall project (e.g. including the LCA Contractor, the Critical Review Contractor, etc.)? If the latter, can you provide further information regarding the anticipated budget for the economic study portion of the project?
 - A1. The maximum budget for the economic portion of this project is \$1.2 million.
 - Q2. In general, does CalRecycle have any expectations regarding the proportion of the budget for the economic study that might be required for the following components of this work: data collection, economic modeling, stakeholder and other meetings and processes?
 - A2. CalRecycle does not have any expectations regarding the proportion of the budget to be allocated to any of the components of this work.
 - Q3. Does CalRecycle expect or desire any sub-state breakdown of the economic analysis and modeling (e.g. regional effects estimates) or is the intention to model and analyze all effects on a statewide basis?
 - A3. Yes it is very likely that some sub-state breakdown will be necessary, probably on a regional rather than city or county level. Also, it is certainly possible that the project boundaries will extend beyond California as the analysis is meant to determine the effects of managing California generated used oil, not strictly used oil managed in California. If used oil is sent from California to another state then effects in that state must also be considered.



Q4. Does CalRecycle expect or desire any geographic specificity regarding estimated economic effects outside of California, or can external effects simply be reported on an aggregated basis?

A4. External effects can be reports on an aggregated basis, however they should be separated between domestic and international.

Q5. Is this procurement open to federally-funded national laboratories and public and private universities, as well as private consulting firms?

A5. Yes
