



population


The number of plants, people, or other animals that live in a place.

To get bigger or spread out.



land use

The way land is used, such as for farming.



nature preserve

A natural area that is set aside so that plants and animals are protected.



settled

An area of land where people have moved to make homes.

The surroundings of a living thing.



natural environment

Places that are not built by people, such as forests, rivers, and deserts.
