

# Lesson 1

## crop

---

A plant grown to be eaten or used as fiber or other material; or, the amount of a plant that is gathered.



# drought

---


A period of time with little or no rainfall or snow.



## natural resources

---

Things that people use from nature, like wood from forests and water from rivers.



# Lesson 2

## distributor

Someone who sells goods to different places.



## processor

---

Someone who prepares goods, such as foods, for sale to stores and people.



## producer

---

A plant that can make its own food in the form of sugars; or, someone who makes or grows goods.

## consumer

---

Someone who buys or uses goods or services.



# population

---

The number of plants, people, or other animals that live in a place.



# trade

---

The buying, selling, or exchange of goods.




# Lesson 4

---
