





## VA #1 Migration Routes to the Americas




1	<b>Land Route:</b> from Asia, over Beringia (Bering Land Bridge)
2	<b>Sea Route:</b> from Asia, sailing close to the shore along the Northern Pacific
3	<b>Sea Route:</b> from Asia, sailing across the Pacific Ocean, settling on islands along the way
4	<b>Sea Route:</b> from Europe, sailing across the Atlantic Ocean








