18 The California Integrated Waste Management Board ("CIWMB") which is now the
19 Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery ("DRRR") served an Administrative
20 Complaint and Request for Hearing form on REYNA MARROQUIN AKA REINA
21 MARROQUIN DBA R-4 TIRE & WHEELS, an unregistered waste and used tire hauler
22 ("RESPONDENT"), on December 18, 2009. RESPONDENT did not file a Request for
23 Hearing. The matter shall be determined as a default pursuant to 14 California Code of
24 Regulations (CCR) section 18466 and Government Code section 11520. The DRRR takes
25 action against RESPONDENT based upon evidence and affidavits that may be used without
26 any notice to RESPONDENT.

28 **FACTUAL FINDINGS**

1. The Administrative Complaint was executed by WENDY BRECKON,
Senior Staff Counsel, CIWMB, acting in her official capacity.

4 Good cause appearing, Complainant's motion to take action in accordance with the
5 provisions of Government Code Section 11520, subdivision (a) is granted.

6 THE FOLLOWING ORDER is hereby made:

7 RESPONDENT, REYNA MARROQUIN AKA REINA MARROQUIN DBA R-4 TIRE &
8 WHEELS, is ordered to pay an administrative penalty of four thousand dollars (\$4,000.00) to
9 the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery within 30 (thirty) days of the date of
10 this Decision.
