Good standard. A thought regarding how toner distributors/mfg/reman can get real serious about your initiative. Why not have them state on their packaging and/or unit that the unit is designed for remfg and it can go thru "x" amount of reman processes before it must become waste. A simple sticker with a 'scratch-off' for each remfg cycle would indicate the remaining life of the cartridge. So one of the drivers for sourcing would be the # of reman cycles that are planned for the unit and the remaining reman cycles. The sticker could be provided by CA and adhered to the unit upon the receipt of a "new" condition unit.
