In the grinding process, wire and fiber byproducts are recovered and removed. The remaining crumb is processed into smaller granules which are sieved and separated into different sizes for various markets or to meet customer specifications.

Tri-C Crumb Rubber can replace higher cost raw materials in many molded rubber products and our 10-16 crumb rubber material is a beneficial feedstock for turf infill. As an ingredient in rubberized asphalt, **Tri-C Crumb Rubber** helps lower road noise and adds to the long-term cost-effectiveness of the pavement.
