

Appendix A - Company Directories

To best assist catalog users, five separate directories are provided on the following pages:

- **Firms Listed in this Catalog** – Includes all firms listed in this catalog, along with the identification of the directories they appear in.
- **Tire-Derived Product Manufacturers** – Includes product manufacturers that manufacture tire-derived products (TDP) or own the intellectual properties and/or tooling rights and contract with another firm to physically manufacture the TDP in California.
- **Tire-Derived Material/Feedstock Suppliers** – Includes scrap tire processors that produce and/or sell size-reduced tire-derived material (TDM) (e.g. such as crumb rubber, chipped or shredded tires).
- **Tire-Derived Product Installers and Contractors** – Includes firms specializing in the design and installation of civil engineering projects, tire-derived playground surfaces, synthetic turf and other tire-derived products.
- **Tire-Derived Pavement Suppliers** – Includes firms that produce paving-related products for a variety of applications that utilize California TDM.
- **Testing and Inspection Companies** – Includes firms that provide independent verification that products satisfy established standards.
- **Retreaders** – Includes firms that retread worn tires for reuse.

Criteria for Inclusion in this Catalog

To be included, a company must:

- 1) Have a valid California business license and be operating out of a physical address in the state. Companies must be actively operating and conducting sales.
- 2) Demonstrate to CalRecycle that they are actively operating and executing sales, and that the TDPs or TDM manufactured, installed or sold in California are made with 100 percent California-generated tires, unless CalRecycle determines that the required crumb rubber specification is not currently available in California. All firms are strongly urged to provide sell sheets that meet minimum quality standards as determined by CalRecycle.
- 3) For inclusion in the Tire-Derived Product Manufacturers Directory, firms must own the rights to their products. Marketing firms are included if they own the intellectual property and/or tooling rights for their products and use contracted California manufacturers to produce products meeting the criteria above. Marketing, distribution and brokering firms without product ownership rights are excluded from the manufacturing category.
- 4) For inclusion in the Tire-Derived Product Installers and Contractors Directory, firms must hold a valid California Contractor's License.

CalRecycle's intent is to equitably represent all California firms satisfying these criteria. CalRecycle reserves the right to exclude firms that it determines do not meeting these criteria, and to exclude marketing materials it determines do not meet the quality standards typically used in this industry, or which contain claims of a questionable or false nature. CalRecycle also reserves the right to limit the number of sell sheets, internet addresses and other information included for each company. References to the firms and their products do not constitute an endorsement by CalRecycle.
