Manufacturing process: Recycled tire crumb rubber is blended with a colorant and polyurethane binder, poured into an aluminum compression mold, heated to 400 degrees and put under pressure for three minutes. The 16"x16"x $\frac{3}{4}$ " pavers are then pulled out of the mold and cooled for 24 hours.
