*Here are some tips everyone can use to minimize waste and prevent pollution. . .*

If you must buy, use, or store hazardous products, you should do the following:

1. Choose the least toxic products needed, use the least amount required, and never mix toxic materials.
2. Read labels carefully: **POISON** means highly toxic and may also be flammable and corrosive too. **WARNING** indicates a less severe hazard. **CAUTION** means less dangerous than **WARNING**.



3. Follow directions for product use and disposal. Know first aid that might be needed.
4. Keep rooms well ventilated and wear proper protection. Wash with soap and water after use.

5. Never dump hazardous products down the toilet, drain, on the ground or in the trash.
6. Store solvents in closed containers and away from heat or flame. Store all hazardous products away from the reach of children.
7. Buy only what you need, in smallest amounts available.
8. Share left over products with your neighbors or family.
9. Use broad spectrum products which work on more than one pest, e.g. boric acid kills both ants and roaches.
