- Collection program at 13 participating retail and nonprofit sites
- Retailers promote the program and educate residents about the proper disposal of lamps.
- Collected nearly 900 fluorescent lamps.
- Other retailers anxious to join the project.



# Most Unique E-Waste Program



Riverside County Waste Management  
CRT Dismantling Program

- Staff de-manufacture CRT devices and other e-wastes “in their spare time”
- Staff dismantle CRTs in two minutes or less.
- Staff morale increased—their input key.
- Components are sorted for recycling markets.
- To date, over 30,000 CRTs have been de-manufactured and recycled.







# Effective Program Design

- Multiple collection options : 19 CCC, Permanent Facilities & ABOPS
- Visit CCC 3-4 times per year
- Bi-lingual radio spots feature different CCC every week
- Outreach thru cable TV, radio, neighborhood councils, annual newspaper supplement, flyers, etc.

# Innovative Urban Program

## Oil Filter Collection Pilot

City of Los Angeles: Recycling Division



- Partnership with 30 Kragen stores
- Filter Exchange Events Each Month
- Flyers distributed in neighborhood
- Utilize GIS to Identify CCC by target neighborhoods
- 12,000 filters collected in 1 year
- 182% increase in filters, 60% increase in used oil recycling
