






# *Used Oil Certified Collection Centers & Abandoned Waste*



## Background




- ★ Legislation (CORE Act) adopted in 1992 to reduce illegal disposal of oil & reclaim used oil
- ★ Collection of \$0.16/gallon fee from oil manufacturers for lubricating oil sales
- ★ Fees provide continuous funding for used oil collection activities
- ★ Centers have a two year certification status
- ★ Value of CCC's
- ★ Approx. 2,600 Cert Used Oil Collection Centers, which include:
  - Auto Parts Stores
  - HHW Collection Facilities (Local Government)
  - Quick Oil Change businesses
  - Auto Repair Shops
  - Specialty (tire, brake, tune-up, etc.)
  - Other (marinas, Ag oil collection sites)



# *Certified Collection Center Requirements*



- ★ Accept used oil from the public (DIYers) and CESQGs. Centers may set levels not less than 5 gal/person/day. Max amt. is 55 gal w/ Center pre-approval per H&S Sec. 25250.11(a)
- ★ Offer "Recycling incentive" of \$0.16/gal; non service bay businesses may offer coupon of at least twice the cash incentive amount
- ★ Informational and/or symbolic signage must be posted
- ★ Check used oil for contamination
- ★ Provide info to DIYers of locations (e.g. Gov HHW facility) where suspected contaminated used oil may be taken






# Used Oil Collection Center Performance

approx. 70% of all DIYer used oil collected or 8.1 million gallons








# *Certified Collection Center Challenges*

- ★ Local Grantee, CUPA and CIWMB liaison








# *Suggested Cert Center Mgt. Practices*






Summer of 2004 pilot effort

  - Improved outreach to DIY-STM's, CESQG's and/or SQG's if evidence of illegal disposal
  - Simplify used oil collection logs




# SMP Sample

# *Local Enforcement Challenges & Opportunities*



- ★ Walking the line between education and enforcement
- ★ **For Grantees:**
  - Site visits & logistics
- ★ **For CUPA's:**
  - If problems are identified, inform the local oil program grantee.
  - When at all possible, take intermediate/warning action
  - Before responding to an abandoned oil/waste report, check with the Operator to see whether they are managing the situation
