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Subject: Comments on the proposed regulations for AB 1497

Dear Ms. Garcia:

The San Bernardino County LEA has reviewed the proposed regulations for AB 1497 and provides the following comments:

1. The LEA supports the Decision Tree concept as a process to identify whether a change in operation or design, is an RFI amendment, modified or revised permit action.
2. The LEA does not support the Alternative 1 Minor Change, Alternative 2 Optional Minor Change or Alternative 3 Significant Change lists as criteria that must be met to implement a change or revise a permit without LEA review or approval.
3. The LEA does not support the proposed noticing for RFI and permit modification applications. The time-line is too short and the changes may be insignificant and not benefit the public. Our records are already subject to the Public Information Act.
