SUBJECT: **Notice of Changes to Proposed Regulations for Form 303 Household Hazardous Waste Collection Report**

On May 3, 2013 CalRecycle will initiate a 15-day comment period for changes to the Proposed Regulations for Form 303 Household Hazardous Waste Collection Report. The 15-day written public comment period for this rulemaking ends at **noon** on May 20, 2013.

This 15-day comment period follows a 45-day public comment period which ran from March 15, 2013 through April 29, 2013. The California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) staff held a public hearing on the proposed regulation on May 1, 2013. After considering comments received during the 45-day comment period and comments made at the public hearing, CalRecycle staff revised the Proposed Regulations for Form 303 Household Hazardous Waste Collection Report. These revisions will add clarity to the existing language where needed.
