

Enforcement





Oakland Municipal Code 8.28.070 Transportation of solid waste on city streets restricted to collector.



- It is unlawful for any person other than the collector or those persons employed by the collector to transport over or upon the streets of the city any solid waste, or source separated yard waste from single-family dwellings, produced in the city, except in those cases described in Section 8.28.060. (Ord. 11819 § 1 (part), 1995: prior code § 6-4.07)



California Penal Code 374.3 Illegal Dumping



- 374.3. (a) It is unlawful to dump or cause to be dumped any waste matter in or upon any public or private highway or road, including any portion of the right-of-way thereof, or in or upon any private property into or upon which the public is admitted by easement or license, or upon any private property without the consent of the owner, or in or upon any public park or other public property other than property designated or set aside for that purpose by the governing board or body having charge of that property.

WARNING NOTICE

USE OF LITTER CONTAINERS

Illegal use of litter containers is in violation of the Oakland Municipal Code Section 8.28.160, of which a pertinent part reads:

"It is unlawful for any person to deposit any material from any building or yard in, on top of, or alongside the street litter receptacles placed in the sidewalk area; provided, that pedestrians and other persons using said streets shall be permitted to deposit in said receptacles miscellaneous small articles of refuse carried by them."

The City is authorized by Oakland Municipal Code 1.12.060 to impose penalties, fines, and administrative fees against you for violating the law. In addition, City Ordinance No. 9336 entitles the City to obtain reimbursement of costs to collect and properly dispose of your illegally dumped debris, of not to exceed \$1,000.00 (one thousand dollars).

ATTENTION HAULING COMPANY OWNER

The City of Oakland has an aggressive campaign aimed at eliminating crime and grime throughout Oakland. A major concern voiced by members of the community and City Officials is the problem of illegal dumping. It is critical that you know the legal way to handle your hauled materials.

8.28.070 Transportation of solid waste on city streets restricted to collector.
It is unlawful for any person other than the collector (**Waste Management Corp.**), or those persons employed by the collector to transport over or upon the streets of the city any solid waste or source separated yard waste from single-family dwellings, produced in the city, except in those cases described in Section 8.28.060. (Ord. 11819 § 1 (part), 1995; prior code § 6-4.07)

Oakland Municipal Code 8.38.170 Dumping garbage.
It is unlawful for any person to dump or place on any land or in any water or waterways within the city, any dead animal, butcher offal, fish or parts of fish, or any waste vegetable or animal matter whatever. (Prior code § 4-5.12)

Oakland Municipal Code 8.38.040 Cost of cleanup.
Any person who dumps or causes to be dumped any waste matter in or upon any public road, including any portion of the right-of-way thereof, or in or upon any public park or other public property other than property designated or set aside for that purpose by the governing board or body having charge of that property is liable to the city for the costs of cleaning up such dumping if that person fails to perform such cleanup or pay to have such cleanup performed.

Further, any person who places, deposits, or dumps or causes to be placed, deposited, or dumped, any rocks or dirt in or upon any road, including any portion of the right-of-way thereof, or in or upon any public park or other public property, without consent of the state or city agency having jurisdiction over road or property shall be liable to the city for the costs of cleanup except as otherwise stated above. (Prior code § 4-5.01)

ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY OF THE OAKLAND MUNICIPAL CODES IS SUBJECT TO FINES UP TO \$5,000, INCLUDING PROSECUTION.

ILLEGAL DUMPERS WILL BE PROSECUTED TO THE FULLEST EXTENT OF THE LAW.

Did you know that illegal dumping can result in fines of up to \$5,000?

A major concern voiced by members of the community and City Officials is the problem of illegal dumping. The City has an aggressive campaign aimed at eliminating crime and grime throughout Oakland.

City staff has observed your truck (license plate number _____) loaded with debris at address _____.

Your vehicle description and license plate number have now been recorded in our data base for tracking of illegal dumping activities. The City will be following up with a letter to the registered owner of the vehicle informing him or her of the above information.

The Oakland Police Department and the Public Works Agency will be conducting citywide enforcement activities. This serves as your warning that we will prosecute violators to the fullest extent of the law.

To properly dispose of the materials in your vehicle, see the reverse side of this letter for a list of options. Your cooperation in complying with the law and properly covering and disposing of the load is critical to Oakland achieving its goal of becoming a cleaner and safer city.



