FRB Info

- 79 Employees at FRB
- Site end use – Passive use park consistent with the Nature Reserve
- MND completed for proposed LNG facility – Prometheus Energy Corp
- 16 water monitoring wells
- Gas:
 - 12 gas monitoring wells
 - 24 miles LFG collection pipe
 - >200 extraction wells
 - 5 LFG flares
- Current elevation 950 feet above mean sea level (amsl) and will remain there for several years
- Refuse is about 350 feet deep
- Green Building
 - Lights turn off automatically
 - Motion sensor and automatic water shutoff on faucets in restrooms
 - Low volume toilets/auto flush
 - Carpet squares for easy replacement of carpet in high-use areas
 - Native, drought-tolerant landscaping
- Toe is about 1 mile from Portola

2002 Landslide

- Amount of dirt excavated – 1.1 mcy (enough to fill a Tustin blimp hanger ½ full)
- Took 4 months to excavate
- Cost \$4.3 million
 - Excavation and relocation of soil
 - Installed horizontal drains
 - CM, CQA, design

EIR 604

- Public review period: Jan 24 – March 9, 2006
- Planning Commission June 2006
- Board of Supervisors July 2006
- Phased vertical & horizontal expansions within existing property boundary
 - Vertical expansion – 250 ft (1,100 ft amsl – 1,350 ft amsl)
 - Horizontal expansion – 193 acres refuse footprint area
 - Increases refuse footprint from 341 acres to 534 acres
 - All expansion occurs within existing 725-acre landfill property
 - Allows for an additional 130 mcy MSW capacity
 - Extends closure date from currently permitted 2022 to approximately 2053
