Dear Mr. Trainer,

CalRecycle has received your letter dated July 1, 2014, requesting certification of the Mattress Recycling Council as the mattress recycling organization, pursuant to section 42987(a)(1) of the Used Mattress Recovery and Recycling Act. The mattress recycling organization, as defined in section 42986(h), must be, among other things, exempt from taxation under section 501(c)(3) or section 501(c)(6) of the Internal Revenue Code. In your letter you stated that the Mattress Recycling Council's application to be exempt from taxation under Internal Revenue Code section 501(c)(3) is still pending before the Internal Revenue Service. With the exception of the tax exempt status, CalRecycle finds the Mattress Recycling Council meets all of the requirements for certification; therefore, CalRecycle conditionally approves the Mattress Recycling Council's certification as the mattress recycling organization, pending approval by the Internal Revenue Service of non-profit status. Please submit a copy of the Mattress Recycling Council's non-profit status when it has been approved by the Internal Revenue Service.
