





What is the
purpose
of a quarantine?

- **Protect** California against the entry of Asian Citrus Psyllid (ACP) and citrus greening/Huanglongbing (CG/HLB) (Federal Quarantine)
- **Prevent the spread** of ACP from known infested areas in the state (State Interior Quarantine/CCR 3435)

Federal Quarantine



- ◆ Federally regulated area (green)
- ◆ Covers state-to-state movement



HOST MATERIAL OF THE FOLLOWING:

- ◆ Plants
- ◆ Plant Parts...

The Federal Order for ACP applies to California too!



- ◆ Shipping host material out of California ACP quarantined area=**prohibited except:**
 - To areas already infested with ACP
 - Or to states that do not have commercial citrus



State Interior Quarantine (CCR 3435)

Prevents the spread of ACP from known infested areas in California to the rest of the State.

ACP in California


Current known CA ACP distribution:

- ◆ Los Angeles County
- ◆ Orange County
- ◆ Imperial County
- ◆ Parts of San Diego County

Also regulated:

- ◆ Parts of Riverside County
- ◆ Parts of San Bernardino

General

Compliance Agreements

- ◆ Legally binding agreement between regulators and industry
- ◆ Specifies how the general requirements in the regulation are carried out

**How is the
compliance
agreement
developed?**

- ◆ Identify current business practices
- ◆ Work with industry to determine best method of mitigation while still allowing movement of product.

- ◆ Sometimes, due to pest risk and lack of effective mitigations measures, movement can be prohibited.

**What green waste
businesses are exempt
from the
State Interior Quarantine?**

◆ If you know you don't move green waste of hosts material

◆ If your business does not move green waste from the quarantine area
