### Introduction

Please be advised that the Sacramento County Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and approved a Joint Technical Document (JTD) Amendment to the Solid Waste Facility Permit for the Kiefer Landfill. The LEA is certified by the California Integrated Waste Management Board to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the County and City of Sacramento, including all active and closed landfills.

### Description of project and LEA's determination

Kiefer Landfill is a 1084-acre existing landfill located at 12701 Kiefer Blvd, north of highway 16, South of Douglas Blvd directly off of Grant Line road, Sloughouse, CA 95683. On April 26, 2007 the LEA received

from Kiefer Landfill a Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) application package to amend the JTD requesting to reformat and update the document to:

- Improve readability;
- Address engineered alternative demonstrations for an evapotranspirative final cover over unlined areas of the landfill which requires Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB) approval;
- Update the detection monitoring program and the leachate management program as required by the RWQCB;
- Include updated facility permits and facility conditions;
- Describe site improvements to the facility entrance, scale house and storm water management system;
- Acceptance of treated wood waste for disposal in the lined portion of the landfill; and
- Operation of a recycle only, Antifreeze, Battery, Oil and Paint (ABOP) and universal waste i.e. fluorescent tubes, thermostats, waste batteries, aerosol cans etc. collection facility.

The LEA finds that the proposed change is consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documents; is consistent with California Integrated Waste Management Board State Minimum Standards; and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current Solid Waste Facilities Permit. The LEA approved the amendment on May 25, 2007.
