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As a property owner, tenant or person with vested interest in the project vicinity, please be advised that the County of Monterey Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) has accepted an RFI amendment application package from the Salinas Valley Solid Waste Authority (SVSWA), for the Crazy Horse Sanitary Landfill in Salinas, CA. The LEA is certified by the California Integrated Waste Management Board to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the County of Monterey, including all solid waste disposal facilities.

### Description of Project

On December 23, 2008, the LEA received a RFI Amendment application package from the SVSWA regarding the Crazy Horse Sanitary Landfill located at 350 Crazy Horse Canyon Road in Salinas, CA. The purpose of the application package was to update the site RFI to install a 260 gallon/day leachate evaporator that is to operate for a maximum of five months.

The leachate evaporator unit utilizes a simple evaporation method by first utilizing an oxidation tank (for odor control), then spraying the oxidized leachate onto plastic panels inside an evaporation tank. Air is circulated through the evaporation tank through forced ventilation to encourage evaporation. The systems energy demands are relatively low, thereby providing an inexpensive and energy efficient means of leachate control.

### Findings

The LEA has determined that:

- The requested amendments do not require a permit revision and may be authorized through an RFI amendment.
- The application is accepted, meets the requirements of the California Code of Regulations, Title 27, Section 21665 (c), and is approved.
- The approved RFI amendment will be incorporated into or replace portions of the existing RFI (January 2005, last revised September 2007).

**Appeals Process Information**
