Proposed Solid Waste Facility Permit Revision for the IMPERIAL LANDFILL

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, in compliance with Section 21660.2 of Title 27 of the California Code of Regulations, that the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) will be conducting an informational meeting regarding a proposed Solid Waste Facility Permit revision for the Imperial Landfill located at 104 East Robinson Road in Imperial, California.

Date/Time: August 8, 2011 at 1:00 P.M.
Location: Public Health Training Center
935 Broadway, El Centro, CA (Corner of 9th Street & Broadway)

Purpose: The meeting is being held to provide information about a proposed revision to the Solid Waste Facility Permit for the Imperial Landfill as requested by Imperial Landfill, Inc., a Republic Services Company. The public will be offered the opportunity to comment and ask the LEA questions about the application package that was accepted for filing on July 22, 2011. A summary of comments from the informational meeting and any written public comments received by the LEA prior to the meeting will be included with the permit revision application package submitted to the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle).

Project Description: The proposed permit revision is for a westward expansion of the landfill to increase the estimated site life from approximately 1-2 years to approximately 30 years of solid waste disposal operations by expanding the permitted disposal area to include an 89-acre waste management unit that will be incorporated into the existing 42-acre unit. An increase in the overall height of the landfill from 95 to 130 feet has also been proposed. The project includes the onsite relocation of scales and scale house and a new public drop off area. The maximum permitted disposal capacity of the site will also increase as described below:

- **Maximum tonnage per day:** 1,700 tons per day (Current Limit: 1,135 tpd)
- **Maximum vehicles per day:** 400 vehicles per day (Current Limit: 274 vpd)
