Pursuant to Assembly Bill 1497, CalRecycle, acting as the Enforcement Agency (EA) for Stanislaus County, will be holding this public information meeting regarding a proposed revision to the SWFP for Modesto Co-Compost Facility. CalRecycle received the application for SWFP revision on November 23, 2010, and accepted it complete and correct for filing on December 16, 2010.

Proposed changes include, but not limited to, the following:

- Relocation of 40 acres of aerated windrow composting operation to an adjacent parcel to the south to accommodate development of Tertiary Treatment Plant.
- Addition of algae, from the Wastewater Treatment Plant, to be used as a feedstock.

The public information meeting is for interested parties to provide comments on the EA's proposed action. The EA's preliminary determination is that the SWFP be revised to incorporate the proposed changes.
