

Public Hearing Notice

Proposed Revision of Solid Waste Facility Permit for City Terrace Recycling/Transfer Station

The Los Angeles County Department of Health Services Solid Waste Management Program, acting as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA), is planning to hold a Public Hearing on the date and time and at the location shown below for the proposed revision of the Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) for City Terrace Recycling/Transfer Station, located at 1511-1533 Fishburn Avenue, Los Angeles (Unincorporated), California 90063.

The proposed revision to the SWFP would allow an increase in the maximum permitted tonnage from 200 tons per day (tpd) to 750 tpd, change days and hours of operation, remove the restriction allowing only PJB Disposal Company owned vehicles to use the facility, and revise site plan. The increase in maximum permitted tonnage will, among other effects, assist the County of Los Angeles in maintaining adequate and cost-effective municipal solid waste disposal capacity, ease the burden on Los Angeles County landfills by transferring additional quantities of the waste stream to outlying landfills as landfills in Los Angeles County reach capacity, and help increase diversion from landfills through recycling of materials from the waste stream.

The Public Hearing is for all interested parties to provide comments on the LEA's proposed action to revise the SWFP for City Terrace Recycling/Transfer Station.
