Proposed Permit Revision for the Salton City Solid Waste Disposal Facility

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, in compliance with Section 21660.2 of Title 27 of the California Code of Regulations, that the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) will be conducting an informational meeting on a proposed permit revision for the Salton City Solid Waste Site.

Purpose: The meeting is being held to provide information about a proposed permit revision for the Salton City Solid Waste Site that is owned by the County of Imperial and operated by Burrtec Waste Industries, Inc. The public will be offered the opportunity to ask the LEA questions about the application package that was accepted for filing on October 30, 2009 and the permit revision process for a solid waste disposal facility. A summary of comments from the informational meeting and any written comments received by the LEA prior to the meeting will be included with the permit application package submitted to the California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB) for concurrence at a public meeting to be held at a later date.

Project: Salton City Solid Waste Site
935 W. Highway 86, Salton City, CA 92275
(Located approximately 3.0 miles west of State Highway 86)

Project Description: The project applicant, Burrtec Waste Industries, is proposing a revision to the Solid Waste Facility Permit to allow the site to increase the days of operation from two days to five days per week, extend the hours of operation for site maintenance, install a truck scale and office, construct an on-site water well to provide for dust control during operations, reconsolidate waste along the eastern portion of the site, reconfigure the final grading plan, install landfill gas monitoring wells, accept residential electronic wastes, expand recycling services, and allow the use of alternative daily cover such as tarps and/or greenwaste. The landfill will continue to accept up to 50 tons of waste per day from residential and commercial haulers, and allow the entrance of up to 150 vehicles per operating day at the site.

Maximum tonnage: 50 tons per day
Traffic volume: 150 vehicle trips (one-way inbound)
Proposed hours of operation: Tuesday – Saturday: 5 A.M. to 6 P.M.
Proposed public hours of operation: Tuesday – Saturday: 7 A.M. to 4 P.M.
(Closed Sundays, Mondays, and Holidays)

Additional information: A copy of the proposed revisions are available for public review in the office of the Imperial County Division of Environmental Health (LEA), located at 797 Main Street, Suite B, in El Centro, California during business hours.
