



**NOTICE OF A PUBLIC MEETING
FOR THE BADLANDS LANDFILL SOLID WASTE FACILITY PERMIT REVISION RECEIVED BY
RIVERSIDE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH, AS THE LOCAL SOLID
WASTE MANAGEMENT ENFORCEMENT AGENCY (LEA)**

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Riverside County Waste Management Department has submitted an application to revise the Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) for the Badlands Sanitary Landfill (facility number 33-AA-0006) to include:

- An increase in the acreage disturbed is being proposed to allow for the construction of a soil stockpile, and two sedimentation basins. This would increase the disturbed area from 246 to 278 acres, an overall increase of 32 acres.
- An airspace capacity increase of approximately 3 million cubic yards.
- An alternative design to the current leachate collection and removal system (LCRS)
- A proposal to construct a second landfill gas flare designed to accommodate a projected increase of gas production.
- An updated Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan.
- An amended closure plan including updated closure costs and post closure maintenance cost estimates.
