

# NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION HEARING

## SOLID WASTE FACILITY PERMIT FOR NORTH BAY CORPORATION

**PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN**, in compliance with AB1497 and California Code of Regulations (CCR), Title 27, Section 21660 to 21660.4, that the County of Sonoma Department of Health Services, Environmental Health Division, Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) will be holding an informational public hearing regarding a New Solid Waste Facility Permit Application for North Bay Corporation, SWIS # 49-AA-0399. The facility is North Bay Corporation Material Recovery Facility located at 3417 Standish Avenue, Santa Rosa, Ca 95407. The contact person for North Bay Corporation is Steve McCaffrey at (707) 586-5533.

The LEA is certified by the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites in the County of Sonoma. John Anderson is the contact person for the LEA. The purpose of the meeting is to inform the public of the preliminary determination action by the LEA regarding the New Solid Waste Facility Permit Application for North Bay Corporation. The application was submitted to the LEA on February 16, 2010, and the application was accepted as complete on March 17, 2010. North Bay Corporation is proposing to:

- Operate a large volume Transfer/Processing Facility on 7.53 acres.
- Receive up to 500 tons per day of source separated material including: curbside single stream recyclables, commercial recyclables, tires, bulky items/appliances.
- Operate the facility on Mon-Fri 4am – 4 pm, Sat and Sun 4am -12 noon.
- Traffic to the proposed facility will include up to 198 vehicles per day
