As a property owner, tenant or person who has requested notice, please be advised that the Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) will be holding a Public Informational Meeting in compliance with Public Resources Code Section 44004 for the purposes of consideration of a proposed Full Solid Waste Facility Permit for the Pico Rivera Materials Recovery Facility. The LEA is certified by the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the Los Angeles County.

Description of Project

Pico Rivera Materials Recovery Facility is an existing facility for commercial use only and accepts single-stream, source-separated recyclable materials generated primarily from the Moreno Valley, Murrieta, and Riverside County areas with lesser amounts coming from surrounding areas. The facility has a Temporary Solid Waste Facility Permit No. 19-AA-1105. The facility is requesting a Full Solid Waste Facility Permit in order to be in compliance with Public Resources Code Section 44002.1. On May 21st, 2010, the LEA accepted the Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) application package as complete and correct.

The proposed new permit will allow for:

- 327 tons per day of recyclable material. (1632 tons weekly average)
- Receipt, handling and processing Mon-Sat 5:30 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
- Transfer of materials Mon-Fri 5:30 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. and Sat 5:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- Maintenance activities occur 24 hours a day / 7 days a week.
- 137 vehicles per day.

Purpose of the Meeting

This Public Informational Meeting is for any interested parties to learn more about the proposed permit and to provide comments to the LEA regarding the proposed action. The meeting is strictly informational and no official decision will be made at the meeting regarding the formal determination on the solid waste facilities permit application.
