Pursuant to Assembly Bill 1497, CalRecycle, acting as the Enforcement Agency (EA) for Stanislaus County, will be holding this public information meeting regarding a proposed revision to the SWFP for Bertolotti Transfer Station. CalRecycle received the application for SWFP revision on September 19, 2011, and accepted it complete and correct for filing on September 20, 2011.

Proposed changes include, but not limited to, the following:

- Increase in tons per day (tpd) from 750 tpd to 950 tpd.
- Increase in the permitted boundary from 5.5 acres to 6.6.
- Addition of 8,000 sq. ft. to existing Transfer Building.
- Addition of floor sorting and chip and grind activities.

The public information meeting is for interested parties to provide comments on the EA's proposed action. The EA's preliminary determination is that the SWFP be revised to incorporate the proposed changes. A copy of the application can be obtained by contacting the EA during regular business hours. If you would like to comment on this project you may do so at the meeting, or you may send your written comments to the EA contact listed above.
