**NOTICE OF LOCAL ENFORCEMENT AGENCY

**VANDENBERG AIR FORCE BASE LANDFILL
PERMIT REVISION APPLICATION**

BACKGROUND:

On November 15, 2010, Santa Barbara County Environmental Health Services, the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) for the California Integrated Waste Management Board, received an application for permit revision regarding the Vandenberg Air Force Base Landfill (Solid Waste Information System No. 42-AA-0012). The landfill is located in North Vandenberg Southeast of Washington and New Mexico Avenue intersection, southwest of Pine Canyon Road, 34.71970 latitude and -120.52418 longitude.

The application reflects operational and design changes described in the application package. The operational changes include modification to the groundwater monitoring network, a new segmented closure process that will consist of three primary phases, and modification to the landfill gas monitoring system. The facility design changes involve an increase in final grade maximum elevation from 450 feet to 466 feet, expansion of the permitted operational boundary from 172 to 217 acres in order to address the lateral migration of landfill gas, and a proposed alternative final cover using an evapo-transpiration cover design. The remaining volumetric capacity has decreased over the past five years from 2,179,447 to 1,984,483 cubic yards and the closure date has been re-estimated at 2060.

LOCAL ENFORCEMENT AGENCY DETERMINATION:

The LEA will host a public meeting that is scheduled to take place on January 13, 2010. The purpose of the meeting is to make public the preliminary determination of the action to be taken by the LEA on the permit application. The LEA has made a preliminary determination that the application package is complete and correct, and that the project requires a revision of the Vandenberg Air Force Base Landfill Solid Waste Facility Permit.
