The Los Angeles County Department of Public Health, Solid Waste Management Program, acting as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) will be holding a Public Informational Meeting for a permit revision. The LEA is certified by the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within its jurisdiction.

Description of Project

This facility is currently accepting solid waste from private commercial haulers Monday through Saturday. The proposed permit revision would allow the facility to also accept solid waste from the public (self-haulers). In addition, the hours for waste receipt on Saturdays would change from closing time of 12 noon to closing time of 2:00 pm. No increase in tonnage is proposed. A Mitigated Negative Declaration was prepared by the Los Angeles County Department of Regional Planning in 2009.

Purpose of the Meeting

This Public Informational Meeting is for any interested parties to learn more about the permit revision and to provide comments to the LEA. The meeting is strictly informational and **no official decision will be made at the meeting** regarding the formal determination on the solid waste facility permit application.
