Pursuant to Assembly Bill 1497, CalRecycle, acting as the Enforcement Agency (EA) for San Luis Obispo County, will be holding this public information meeting regarding a proposed new SWFP for B. Goodrow, Inc. CalRecycle received the application for SWFP on April 19, 2012, and accepted it complete and correct for filing on May 14, 2012.

Currently, this operation operates under an EA Notification. The proposed changes require the operation to obtain a solid waste facilities permit. The proposed changes in the design and operation include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Allow a maximum of 50,000 cubic yards of material on site.
- Conversion from windrows to aerated static piles.
- Expand the facility boundary from 5.86 acres to 8.03 acres.
- Allow for the addition of food waste to be used as a feedstock.

The public information meeting is for interested parties to provide comments on the EA's proposed action.
