Pursuant to Assembly Bill 1497, CalRecycle, acting as the Enforcement Agency (EA) for Stanislaus County, will be holding this public informational meeting regarding a proposed revision to the SWFP for Recology Grover Environmental Products, Inc. CalRecycle received the application for SWFP revision on November 22, 2011, and accepted it complete and correct for filing on December 20, 2011.

Proposed Change: Recology Grover Environmental Products is an existing composting operation in Stanislaus County. Proposed changes include an increase in tons per day (tpd) from 125 tpd to 125 tpd monthly average with a daily peak not to exceed 250 tons. There are no changes to the hours, acreage or material types accepted.

The public informational meeting is for interested parties to provide comments on the EA's proposed action. The EA's preliminary determination is that the SWFP be revised to incorporate the proposed changes. A copy of the application can be obtained by contacting the EA during regular business hours.
