Pursuant to Assembly Bill 1497, CalRecycle, acting as the Enforcement Agency (EA) for San Benito County, will be holding this public information meeting regarding a proposed SWFP revision for the John Smith Road Landfill. CalRecycle received the application for SWFP revision on December 28, 2012, and accepted the application as complete and correct for filing on January 17, 2013.

The proposed changes in the design and operation include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Allow disposal of 1,000 tons per day of material.
- Expand permitted facility boundary by 33.81 acres for a total of 90.36 acres.
- Expand disposal footprint from 44 acres to 58 acres.
- Designate recyclable material not to be counted towards the daily tonnage per the Mitigated Negative Declaration Analysis.

The public information meeting is for interested parties to provide comments on the EA's proposed action. The EA's preliminary determination is that the SWFP be revised to incorporate the proposed changes.
