Proposed Solid Waste Facility Permit Revision for the Salton City Solid Waste Facility #13-AA-0011

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, in compliance with Section 21660.2 of Title 27 of the California Code of Regulations, that the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) will be conducting an informational meeting regarding a proposed Solid Waste Facility Permit to expand the landfill.

Purpose: The meeting is being held to provide information about a proposed revision to the Solid Waste Facility Permit for the Salton City Solid Waste Facility. The public will be offered the opportunity to comment and ask the LEA questions about the application package that was accepted for filing on August 9, 2013. A summary of comments from the informational meeting and any written public comments received by the LEA prior to the meeting will be included with the permit revision application package submitted to the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) for consideration.

Project Description: The proposed permit revision is requested to increase the estimated site life of the Salton City Solid Waste Facility an additional 25 years by expanding the permitted disposal area from 7.8 acres to 284 acres within the 320 acre parcel. The maximum design height of the landfill will also be increased from an elevation of 15.5 feet to 218 feet above mean sea level. Operational revisions include increasing the maximum permitted tonnage to 6,000 tons per day delivered to the site by up to 723 vehicles per day. The increase in daily tonnage disposed at the facility is planned to be phased and the initial phase of operations will be limited to 3,000 tons per day. The current Solid Waste Facility Permit limits the facility to a maximum daily tonnage of 50 tons and a maximum of 150 vehicles per day. The operator also proposes to increase the hours of operation to 24 hours per day 7 days a week for site maintenance and acceptance of long-haul transfer vehicles for waste delivery. The facility will be open to the public and commercial vehicles for waste disposal from Monday to Saturday between the hours of 7 A.M. and 5 P.M.
