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The Los Angeles County Department of Public Health, Solid Waste Management Program, acting as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) will be holding a Public Informational Meeting for a permit revision for Savage Canyon Landfill. The LEA is certified by the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within Los Angeles County.

## Description of Project

Revision of the 1995 Solid Waste Facility Permit and the current Joint Technical Document to incorporate the following items:

- Correction of disposal acreage in the solid waste facility permit from 132 acres to 102 acres.
- Clarification of landfill maximum elevation from 900' to 910' at the ridgeline to incorporate a 3% grade for drainage.
- Incorporation of 3,000 tons per day of inert debris for beneficial use into the solid waste facility permit (the pre-1970's practice of importing clean soil was never officially listed in the facility solid waste permit).
- Clarification of a total landfill capacity increase from 14.95 million cubic yards to 19.34 million cubic yards due to a 1996 grading plan that revised a 1989 grading plan to improve the volumetric capacity of the landfill without any increase to the waste footprint.
- Correction of landfill closure date from 2025 to 2055 (to be consistent with the 1996 grading plan).

## Purpose of the Meeting

This Public Informational Meeting is for any interested parties to learn more about the permit revision and to provide comments to the LEA. The meeting is strictly informational and **no official decision will be made at the meeting** regarding the formal determination on the solid waste facility permit application.
