The California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), acting as the solid waste Enforcement Agency (EA) for the City of Stockton, will be holding this public information meeting to consider a proposed revision to the SWFP that includes the following change:

- Receipt of materials and maintenance 24 hours a day, Monday through Sunday.

On March 11, 2014, the EA accepted the application to revise the SWFP submitted by Recology Stockton. The EA's preliminary determination is that the SWFP be revised to incorporate the proposed change and incorporate updates to the Transfer/Processing Report.
