As a property owner, tenant, or person who has requested notice, please be advised that Inyo County Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and is considering an application to revise the solid waste facility permit (SWFP) for the Shoshone Landfill. The LEA is certified by CalRecycle to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the County of Inyo, including all active and closed landfills.

Description of project, LEA's preliminary determination and date LEA accepted permit

Shoshone Landfill is an approximately 50-acre existing landfill site located 1 Mile East of Shoshone, CA, accessed via gravel road off Hwy 178. This facility is closed to the public and is only open to the Inyo County Road Department. On December 16, 2013, the LEA accepted for review the permit application package to the SWFP from Inyo County Integrated Waste Management requesting a revision to update the ownership of the of the landfill property from the Bureau of Land Management to the County of Inyo which occurred via a land patent dated March 13, 2012. Other changes to the SWFP are also under consideration at this time and include: a change to the facility size from the previously leased property of 20 acres to the new patent area of 50.15 acres, site capacity changes due to more accurate digital subtraction of final grades and topography, and a change in the disposal footprint to account for the new and larger patent area now encompassing historic, pre-1988, waste.

The LEA's preliminary determination is that the proposed permit revision be approved. **The proposed revision to the SWFP would NOT allow an increase in tonnage, traffic, or expansion of the landfill.**

Purpose of the Meeting

This Public Hearing is for any interested parties to learn more about the proposed permit revision and to provide comments to the LEA regarding the proposed action. The decision to issue or not to issue the SWFP revision must be made by the LEA within 120 days of the date the application was deemed complete as required by Statute. Prior to issuance of the SWFP, the LEA must request and receive concurrence from CalRecycle. If you wish to be notified of the CalRecycle meeting, please notify the LEA in writing no later than January 31, 2014.
