### Introduction

The Los Angeles County Department of Public Health Solid Waste Management Program (SWMP), acting as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA), is certified by the California Integrated Waste Management Board to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities within its jurisdiction. As required by Section 21660.1 of Title 27 of the California Code of Regulations (27 CCR), the SWMP is distributing this notice for the purposes of a Report of Facility Information (RFI) amendment to the Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) for AVPL II.

### Description of Project and LEA's Determination

AVPL II is an approximately 75-acre existing landfill located in northeast Los Angeles County within the incorporated boundaries the City of Palmdale. Although the landfill has been permitted since June 12, 1997, waste was not received there until this year on April 2<sup>nd</sup>. On April 19, 2007, the LEA received from Waste Management, a SWFP application package to amend the RFI to incorporate residential curbside greenwaste material as Alternative Daily Cover (ADC). Although processed green material is already an approved ADC, an LEA condition in the SWFP requires a pilot project to be conducted for the use of all new ADC material. In order to meet this condition, Waste Management submitted a pilot project description, which outlined how the

ADC material would be managed and applied. The two week pilot project was successfully completed on May 13, 2007.

The LEA finds that the proposed change is consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted CEQA documents, is consistent with State Minimum Standards, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current SWFP, pursuant to Section 21665(c) of 27 CCR. The LEA approved the RFI amendment on May 18, 2007.
