Introduction

The Placer County Department of Health & Human Services, Environmental Health Services, acting as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA), is certified by the California Integrated Waste Management Board to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities within its jurisdiction. The Auburn Transfer Station operates under a Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) issued by the LEA and has filed a Report of Facility Information (RFI), which describes the design and operation of the facility, with the LEA.

Description of Project

The operator has proposed changes to the RFI in order to update information regarding the quantity of green waste allowed to be stored on-site, to reflect the new name for an RFI prepared for a transfer station, and has added clarifications to the text pursuant to the LEA's request. No other changes in site design or operation are proposed.

LEA's Determination

The operator submitted an application for a 5-Year Permit Review and RFI Amendments to the LEA on 4-12-07 with revisions submitted on 5-22-07. The LEA reviewed the application and determined that the proposed changes are consistent with the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act documents, specifically Negative Declaration (SCH 95032043), NOD filed 4-4-96 and Addendum Negative Declaration (SCH 95032043), dated 8-18-97. The LEA further determined that the proposed changes are consistent with the State Minimum

Standards, and do not conflict with the terms and conditions of the current SWFP, pursuant to Title 27 California Code of Regulations (27 CCR), Section 21665(c). The LEA approved the RFI amendments May 23, 2007.

As required by 27 CCR 21660.1, the LEA is distributing this notice for the purpose of noticing its acceptance of the amendments to the RFI for the Auburn Transfer Station.
