Introduction

Please be advised that the County of Sacramento Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and approved a Transfer Processing Report (TPR) Amendment to the Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) for Elder Creek Recovery and Transfer Station. The LEA is certified by the California Integrated Waste Management Board to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities within the County and City of Sacramento.

Description of project and LEA's determination

Elder Creek Recovery and Transfer Station (ECRTS) is a 19.26 acre site in the City of Sacramento and is owned and operated by Allied Waste Industries, Inc. ECRTS is designed to assist the County of Sacramento and other jurisdictions in complying with local waste reduction and recycling goals and ordinances. ECRTS accepts residential and commercial refuse. This facility is located at 8642 Elder Creek Road, Sacramento, CA 95828. On August 29, 2008 the LEA received from ECRTS, a SWFP application package to amend the TPR requesting to revise the document to:

- Change the location of MRF sort line.
- Add to the TPR that the transfer station is a Consolidation Point for home generated sharps.

No other change to the SWFP is under consideration at this time. The LEA finds that the proposed changes are consistent with the California Integrated Waste Management Board State Minimum Standards, and is consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documents. The proposed changes do not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current Solid Waste Facilities Permit. The LEA approved the amendment on September 25, 2008.
