PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, in compliance with California Code of Regulations (CCR) Title 27, Section 21660.1(b), that the Humboldt County Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Environmental Health, Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) has approved an application for a Report of Facility Information (RFI) Amendment at the Hawthorne Street Transfer Station.

Description of Change: Amendment of the Transfer Processing Report to implement a compostable materials diversion program at the Hawthorne Street Transfer Station. The operation of this program involves handling and transferring source-separated food waste and other compostable materials separately from the rest of the solid waste stream. The LEA's findings pursuant to §21665(c) are as follows:

The LEA finds that the proposed change is consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted CEQA documents in that no subsequent EIR or Negative Declaration or supplemental EIR is warranted.

The LEA has deemed the proposed change acceptable and consistent with, but not limited to, State minimum standards pursuant to CCR 27 Chapter 3, Subdivision 1, Division 2.

The LEA finds the changes do not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current solid waste facilities permit.
