The Los Angeles County Department of Public Health, Solid Waste Management Program (SWMP), acting as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) is certified by the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within its jurisdiction. Compton Recycling and Transfer Station operates under a Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) issued by the SWMP. On **May 23, 2013**, the operator filed an application for amendments to their Report of Facility Information (RFI).

LEA's Determination

Pursuant to Title 27, California Code of Regulations (27 CCR), Section 21665 (c), SWMP reviewed the application and determined that the proposed change is consistent with all adopted CEQA documents, is consistent with State Minimum Standards and do not conflict with the terms and conditions of the current SWFP.
