The Riverside County Department of Environmental Health, Solid Waste Management Program, acting as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) is certified by the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within its jurisdiction. The Robert A. Nelson Transfer Station operates under a Solid Waste Facility Permit issued by the LEA. The operator has filed an application for an RFI amendment with the LEA. The RFI describes the design and operation of the facility.

As required by 27 CCR, Section 21660.1, the LEA is distributing this notice for the purpose of noticing its acceptance of the amendments to the RFI for Robert A. Nelson Transfer Station and MRF.

Description of Project

The RFI amendment application addresses the following change:

1. The addition of two walking floor transfer trailers for the storage of waste tires.

### LEA's Determination

An application for an RFI amendment was received by the LEA on September 5, 2013. Pursuant to 27 CCR, Section 21665(c), the LEA reviewed the application and determined that the proposed change is consistent with all adopted CEQA documents, is consistent with State Minimum Standards and does not conflict with the terms and conditions of the current SWFP. The LEA approved the RFI amendments on October 3, 2013.
