ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS

Public entities (i.e., California cities, counties, public colleges, public universities, school districts, qualifying California Indian Tribes, park districts, special districts, public recreational facilities, fire stations, and police stations). Only one application per qualifying public entity will be accepted. An application may include multiple tire-derived products/projects.

ELIGIBLE PRODUCTS/PROJECTS

Eligible Tire-Derived Products (TDP) are made from 100% recycled California waste tires. Tire buffings are not eligible for reimbursement under the TDP Grant Program. Tire buffings may be used in the product/project, but will not be reimbursed by CIWMB.

NUMBER OF TIRES DIVERTED

- Minimum of 2,500 CA tires diverted per proposed tire-derived products/projects
- An application may include multiple products/projects to achieve a combined minimum of 2,500 CA tires diverted

AVAILABLE FUNDS

- \$ 2,400,000 available for FY 2006/2007
- \$ 100,000 maximum available per grant
- Up to \$7 per tire diverted, with priority given to applications whose projects have a ~~an actual~~ cost per tire of \$5 or less.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

Applications must be postmarked or, if hand-delivered, date stamped by the California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB) no later than **November 15, 2006** ~~September 15, 2006~~. Hand delivered applications will be accepted at Cal/EPA Headquarters Building located at 1001 "I" Street, Sacramento, CA until **3:00 p.m. on November 15, 2006** ~~September 15, 2006~~. Faxed or e-mailed applications will not be accepted. Late applications will be returned and will not be considered for grant funding.

Applications mailed or sent by U.S. Postal Service or a commercial delivery service should be sent by a means that allows for tracking by the sender and that provides an addressed and dated receipt, demonstrating mailing to the CIWMB's address. Failure to do so is at the risk of the applicant and if delivery is delayed or the application is lost by the delivery service, the burden is on the applicant to demonstrate timely mailing or delivery of the application.
